SCHOOL DINNERS - REMINDER



School Dinner Money for children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 should be paid in advance half termly. As there are 8 weeks to this half term (minus 1 day), the amount due is calculated at £2.55 per day, £12.75 per week; £99.45 for the term. Any credits from the Summer Term will be deducted. Payments are to be made online via SchoolMoney where you have the option to part pay or pay in full. Bills are calculated for the half-term and adjustments for any dinners not taken due to trips or illness will be made the following half-term. Payments for this half-term

will be available on-line from next week. Miss Stubbs will be happy to advise on any queries you may have and is in school on Mondays and Wednesdays.

A reminder also that should you wish to move from school dinners to packed lunches or vice versa please can you give at least **one week's** notice, in writing.

MISS WELBURN - OPERATION

Miss Welburn our Year 6 teacher will be going into hospital in October to have her tonsils removed. She will remain at school until the operation but is being very vigilant, as catching tonsillitis or covid will mean putting the operation back. We would be very grateful if you would let us know if your child has a sore throat, or if they or anyone in your household has tonsillitis. Please do not send children to school if they are infectious with tonsillitis. Please could you also inform us if any pupil is covid positive. Thank you for your help with this very important matter.

WALKING BUS

The walking bus service will stop at the end of October due to Mrs Glew's circumstances changing.



Just a bit about the walking bus service - In a morning parents drop their children off at Church Field's car park, which is next to St Mary's Church on the high street in Boston Spa at 8.30am then Mrs Glew (a parent at St Edward's) and another volunteer walk the St Edward's children to school.

Currently there are 14 parents that take advantage of this service, and it would be a shame to let the Walking Bus lapse. Are there any parents who are willing to take this role on? Currently with 14 children there needs to be at least 2 adults to help. This is a completely voluntary service.

The more adults who do help, the more children can talk part in the walking bus, helping to alleviate traffic and parking issues.
